This Course is ideal for anyone who works with individuals with Specific Learning Difficulties and would like to increase their understanding.

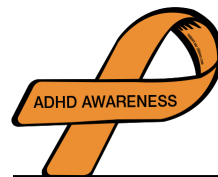
We are taking enrolments now and the coursework will be issued to the learner in approximately 4 weeks time.
